Prose	Poetry
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Most everyday writing is in prose form.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Poetry is typically reserved for expressing something special in an artistic way.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The language of prose is typically straightforward without much decoration.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The language of poetry tends to be more expressive or decorated, with comparisons, rhyme, and rhythm contributing to a different sound and feel.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ideas are contained in sentences that are arranged into paragraphs.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ideas are contained in lines that may or may not be sentences. Lines are arranged in stanzas.</li></ul>
